Surface Preparation:

Clean surface with $3M^{TM}$ Marine Multi-Purpose Boat Soap (light duty), other remaining contaminants can be removed with $3M^{TM}$ General Purpose Adhesive Cleaner, P. N. 08984.

High gloss will be returned to parts with original high polished surfaces. Test for suitability on brushed and matted surfaces.

Not recommended for painted , anodized or clear coatings which may have been applied to the metal. Will not remove severe pitting of metal.

Application:

Hand Application:

- 3M^[™] Perfect-It[™] Wax and Glaze Wipes or Scotch-Brite[™] High Performance Cloths are recommended for application.
- 2. Apply material to small area using a soft, clean cloth.
- 3. Rub aggressively using short strokes.
- 4. Keep turning the cloth as more material is applied.
- 5. Buff to a high luster using a clean, soft cloth. **Do not allow to haze.**

Cleanup:
