JOINT DESIGN

When using **Geocel**® 580 in joint configurations the minimum width and depth should be 10mm, and maximum width should not exceed 25mm.

SURFACE PREPARATION

Ensure that all surfaces are clean, dry, sound and grease free. Clean all joints of release agents, water repellents, laitance, dust, dirt, old sealants, and other contaminants, which could impair adhesion. Metal surfaces should be cleaned and degreased by wiping with a suitable solvent on an oil and lint free cloth.

Note: When using a solvent, always provide adequate ventilation. Avoid heat, sparks and open flames. Observe and follow all precautions listed on solvent container label. It is recommended that **Geocel® 580** is not applied to surfaces that are below 5°C as it is impossible to guarantee a dry, frost free surface at this temperature.

MASKING

Areas adjacent to the joints should be masked with tape to prevent contamination of substrates and to ensure a neat sealant line. Masking tape should be removed immediately after tooling.

PRIMING

When used in conjunction with most common construction substrates, a primer is not required.

BACK-UP MATERIAL

Closed cell polyethylene backer rod is recommended where a back-up material is required. Low tack polyethylene tape should be used in joints too shallow to allow the use of backer rod. Backer rod is available from **Geocel**®.

APPLICATION

Apply Geocel 580 with a cartridge gun, drawing the gun smoothly along the joint and exerting an even pressure, ensuring the mastic is forced well into the joint and that it makes full contact with the joint sides.

FINISHING

The joint should be 'tooled' within five minutes of application to ensure good contacts between the sealant and the substrate. Tooling of the sealant also gives a smooth, professional finish.

CLEANING

Excess mastic should be removed from tools immediately.

LIMITATIONS

Do not apply to bitumen, asphalt or coal tar based materials.

Geocel® **580** has a limited movement capability. It should not be used for pointing of micro-porous or stain-finished timber. PVC-U or aluminium frames.

PACKAGING

Geocel* 580 is supplied in 380ml cartridges packed in boxes of 20.
