riton as a brand seem to ebb and flow like the tides, they come, they go and now they are back again – hopefully for good. So we thought we would take a look at one of their newest offerings.

This machine is a rough looking cookies mot too leg but heavy and very sold construction. It comes with a cast iron table and the spindle takes a series of five different size diameter rubber drums. grade of aluminium oxide grit. The reason for five drums only, is because the smallest diameter of abrasive sleeve fits on the spindle alone without a rubber drum. To mount an abrasive,

a special metal disc is dropped down the spindle. Fit the appropriate inner tring, then side a close fitting sleeve on to its drum and slide that on the spindle, then add the washers and tighten the nut clockwise. The action of tightening it down firmly expands the drum so the abrasive fits tightly on to it. Extraction of course is a must – handy if you can use an auto switching extractor with it.

Verdict

Mounting and swapping abrasives, drums and inserts is a quick and
